My son XXX has ADHD, ASD and Tourette Syndrome has been quite relaxed at home as he has everything he needs. That said, he's struggled to focus on his school work and that concerns me.

XXX is very bright and excels in subjects he finds interesting but I'm fairly sure that if his school considers the quantity of work he's done at home when they decide on the class sets in the September term, he'll be put down a set. I feel that schools should use the work that children did up until the schools closed to make their decisions.

Many parents who I've spoken too in my role as a caseworker have said similar things.
