Hi my childminder has told me she has been advised they will not be able to do pick up/drop offs from school in September. I have been an auxillary nurse at the Royal Gwent for 18 months and had intended on going to university next year to study nursing the nursing degree.

Nurses start work at 7am. I rely upon my childminder to have XXXXX from 06:30. I'm a single parent

As a student nurse I will be expected to start at 07:00 with the other nurses and at the end of the day she would pick him up as it's a 12 hour shift. Even in the community nursing I wouldn't finish before 3pm. I don't have any family support my mother is dead I have no one else to pick up my little boy
