Dear Sir,

I would like to make some observations about the public service to Cardiff Airport. There is now only one bus to the airport from the centre of Cardiff every two hours. This should be reinstated to the hour service - especially as now there is no link from Rhosee Station.

I use the Airport fairly often, as recommended by the Assembly, use public transport wherever possible.

In order to catch a flight to Belfast at 11.55, I have to leave my house at 8 AM - the bus leaves for the Airport at 9.

so I reach the Airport at 9.30 for a 10.45 ch
in. On the return journey the bus leave
the airport every two hours. This does not
encourage visitors at all.

Since BML have left Cardiff Airport, the
only carrier is Flybe - as a consequence
the fares are very expensive. My family
fly - Easy Jet to Bristol because of the cost.
This makes for a longer journey, but it is
still cheaper than flying Flybe to Cardiff.
