The First Minister: I issued a written statement on 13 February on the European Union budget, advising Members of our disappointment that it failed to deliver a fair structural funds allocation to the most vulnerable regions, including west Wales and the Valleys. The Deputy Minister for Agriculture, Food, Fisheries and European Programmes wrote to Members two weeks ago.
