Thank you for your letter of 12 October regarding the petition you have received in relation to charging for parking and the relationship to high streets.

Each local authority is responsible for setting parking charges in its own car parks and the Welsh Government does not have powers to intervene or challenge those decisions. In June, I published research that I commissioned to examine the relationship between car parking charges and town centre footfall in Wales. I recognise that there is a range of views about the relationship between car parking provisions and high street activity. I believe that local authorities are best placed to determine the charges to be levied in their own car parks as part of their overall car parking strategy. When setting this strategy, I believe it is important that local authorities should consult widely and fully with local people and businesses.
