12	<p>An adult who was diagnosed in childhood & who has been refused services in the past (possibly due to IQ) will be ignored, out of the loop, with no pathway available, and may not know how to seek help.</p> <p>Assessments should also be given to these persons when requested by the person with ASD, a parent, a teacher or anyone else who recognises the difficulties the person is experiencing. This must lead to appropriate support.</p> <p>What has prevented the support in the past is a complete lack of services for those with an ASD, due to lack of funding & lack of appropriate training of the people listed above.</p>
